This Indenture made the third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between William Collier and wife Agnes Collier of the County of Washington and Territory of the one part and Behemiah Williams of the County of Washington and Commonwealth of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Collier and wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds current money of Virginia to the said William Collier and wife in hand paid by the said Behemiah Williams the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge the said William Collier & wife hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Behemiah Williams his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and seventy four acres be the same more or less the said 174 acres is part 996 acres granted to Charles Sinclair deceased by patent bearing date the eighth day of August 1753 and by the said Charles Sinclair last Will and Testament made in the year 1766 and left to the said Agnes Collier who was legatee of the said Charles Sinclair deceased by his last Will as aforesaid lying and being in the County of Washington and State aforesaid and is known by the name of Sinclair's Bottom on the South fork of Colden river and bounded as followeth Beginning on a white oak and a dogwood on a rock on the south side of the river North westerly that two hundred and sixty eight poles to two white oaks a corner to Robert Sinclair's land and with his line North sixty eight degrees East one hundred and fifteen poles to two white oaks a corner to Sabers Main and with his line South fifteen degrees East two hundred and eighty three poles to a large white oak on the South side of the river South eighty one degrees West one hundred poles to the Beginning together with its appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the said tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Behemiah Williams and his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Collier & wife and their heirs will forever warrant and defend the said tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Behemiah Williams and his heirs against the claims all persons whatsoever.
