In collecting the names, and sorvice of the soldiers of all wars for the McDonough Soldiers Monument, we realized how few records were to be found of the pioneers, of this locality, with few descendants left, and in many cases more at all.


These early settlers were a fine body of people, who have made history of this vicinity. And thus it seemed wise to preserve what ever could be found about them.
